ABOUT THE AWARDS

PAEMST is the Nation's highest honors for K-12 STEM teachers. Awardees serve as models for their colleagues, inspiration to their communities, and leaders in the improvement of STEM education. Since 1983, more than 5,200 teachers have been recognized for their contributions to STEM education. Up to 110 teachers are recognized each year.

AWARDEES RECEIVE

- A certificate signed by the President of the U.S
- A paid trip to D.C. for a series of recognition events and professional development opportunities
- A \$10,000 award from NSF
- An opportunity to build lasting partnerships with colleagues across the nation

The National Science Foundation administers PAEMST on behalf of the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy.

WHO CAN NOMINATE?

Anyone—principals, teachers, parents, students, or members of the general public may nominate exceptional science, technology, engineering, and/or mathematics teachers.

Nominations are due January 8, 2024.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Elementary school science, technology, engineering, and/or mathematics teachers (K–6) can apply this year. Secondary school teachers (7–12) will be eligible to apply during a future cycle.

Applications are due February 6, 2024.
